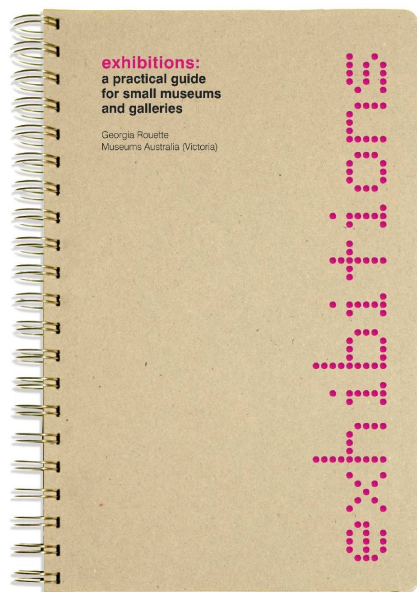

EXHIBITIONS BOOK WINS INTERNATIONAL DESIGN PRIZE

Museums Australia (Victoria) has won First Prize in the 2008 American Association of Museums Museum Publications Design Awards for *Exhibitions: a practical guide for small museums and galleries*.

Written by Museums Australia (Victoria)'s Manager of Touring Services, Georgia Rouette, and designed by the Melbourne firm Ektavo, the publication won First Prize in the category of 'books published by an institution with a budget of less than US \$750,000'.
