

Exhibition Grants Call for Applications



Museums Australia (Victoria) invites all museums* located in Victoria to apply for the 2010 round of grants to develop either a static or touring exhibition. This year two new categories include funding for an online exhibition and the development of a digital story.

Exhibition Grants are available to organisations to develop a collections based exhibition for either their venue or to tour.

Grants of up to \$10,000 are open for organisations to:

1. Develop a static exhibition
2. Tour an exhibition
3. Apply for exhibition infrastructure
4. Develop an online exhibition (new)
5. Develop a digital story (new)

Funds can be used to assist with exhibition research, concept development, content development, developing an exhibition brief, engaging an independent curator, creating education kits for public programs, exhibition design for travelling, producing an exhibition catalogue, preparing a touring manual, purchasing display equipment and infrastructure, or to carry out special projects related to touring exhibitions.
